



NOTICE OF STORMWATER AND ROADWAY RESURFACING PROJECT ON CORAL SEA ROAD

The area around Cutler Ridge Elementary School will undergo several construction improvements during the summer break months. The Town of Cutler Bay has received a grant from the FDEP to improve the existing stormwater drainage system, sidewalks and pavement along Coral Sea Road between Cutler Ridge Drive and Bahia Drive. The work is expected to alleviate the existing draining deficiencies in the area and improve the water quality of the stormwater run off. Upon completion of these stormwater improvements, the roadway will be completely resurfaced and additional stormwater drainage structures will be operational. The scope of work includes repairing all of the damaged sidewalks located around the perimeter of Cutler Ridge Elementary.

Construction is anticipated to begin on June 9, 2009 and substantially completed by August 21, 2009. Access to school property will be maintained during construction, however, traffic patterns in the area may be altered as the project progresses.
