



NOTICE OF STORMWATER AND ROADWAY RESURFACING PROJECT WITHIN SAGA BAY COMMUNITY

The area within the Saga Bay Community will undergo several stormwater improvements during the upcoming months.

The improvements are expected to alleviate the existing draining deficiencies in the area and improve the water quality of the stormwater run off. Upon completion of these improvements, the affected roadways will be completely resurfaced and additional stormwater drainage structures will be operational.

Construction is anticipated to begin on August 19, 2009 and substantially completed by November 30, 2009. Access to local roads will be maintained during construction however, traffic patterns in the area may be altered as the project progresses.

The Town of Cutler Bay has received a grant from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection in order to improve the existing stormwater drainage system, sidewalks and pavement throughout the Saga Bay drainage basins 1.3 and 1.4.

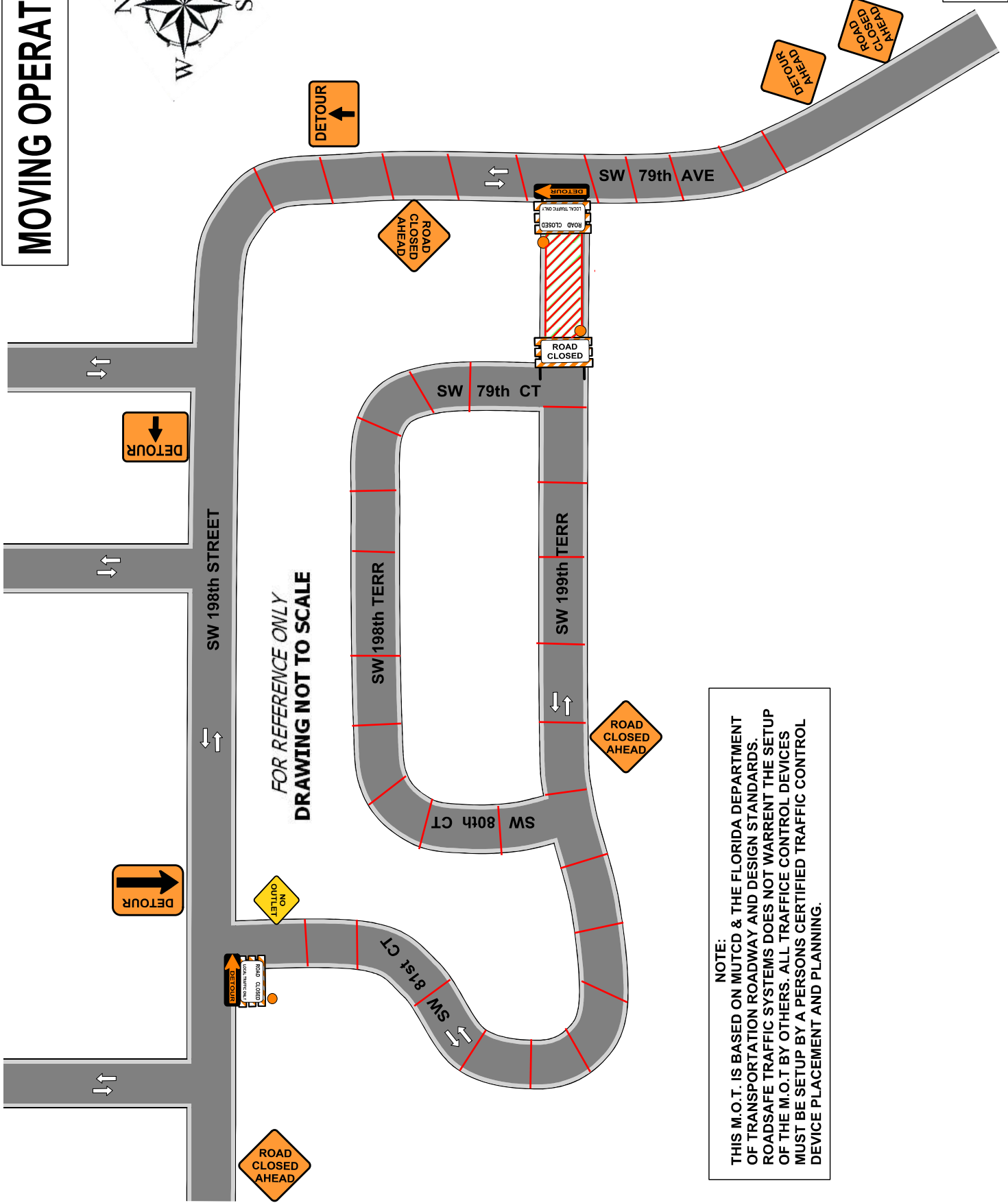
