



Old Cutler Road Improvements Project

PROJECT FACTS:

- Project limit: Old Cutler Road from SW 97 Ave to SW 87 Ave (1.25 miles)
- Construction of two traffic calming circles at the intersections of Old Cutler Road on SW 97 Ave and SW 87 Ave
- Installation of decorative street lighting & traffic signals, new storm-water drainage system, native pineland landscaping, decorative treatments at key intersections, & new pedestrian sidewalks
- Re-construction of the existing roadway
- Construction of new decorative bus shelters & benches
- Construction of new shared used bike and pedestrian path

COST: \$ 7,524,319 (via a Joint Participation Agreement)

FUNDING SOURCE: People's Transportation Plan (PTP) & Town of Cutler Bay

ESTIMATED TIME OF COMPLETION: "anticipated" **Fall 2013**

PROJECT BACKGROUND: The Town of Cutler Bay incorporated as a Municipality in 2005. The Town has taken every effort to continue the hard work of Miami-Dade County, particularly in its "Charrette Areas" of which Old Cutler Road is one. In doing so, the goals of this project are to improve public safety, ease traffic congestion, enhance traffic flow, enhance pedestrian mobility, improve function and flow of mass transit and beautify the neighborhood with streetscape improvements. In addition the project will enhance the existing shared use path and provide a continuous storm drainage system, street lighting, traffic signalization and landscaping. Two traffic circles will be added to the project, on 87 Ave & Old Cutler Road, replacing the signalized intersection and the other at SW 97 Ave & Old Cutler Road.
