Cutler Bay Awarded Grant

At the Town's last Council meeting, Cutler Bay accepted a \$210,000 grant from South Florida Water Management District for the Bel-Aire sub-basin stormwater/pollutant elimination project. The project will provide improved flood protection locally, and improved water quality in the C-1N Canal and the downstream receiving water body, Biscayne Bay. This will be accomplished by increasing the efficiency and capacity of the existing drainage system and by implementing standard treatment technologies for stormwater runoff. The total cost of the project is \$450,000 which includes a Cutler Bay grant match of \$240,000. For more information, contact Town Hall at (305) 234-4262.

Brief Legislation from the October 21, 2009 Town Council Meeting:

- Adopted Resolution 09-75 approving the selection of Konica Minolta for the lease of copiers for various departments within the Town.
- Adopted Resolution 09-76 accepting a grant award from South Florida Water Management District in the amount of \$210,000 for the Bel-Aire sub-basin stormwater/pollutant elimination program.
- Adopted Resolution 09-77 approving the selection of 1,071 sq. ft. of office space from Pinnacle Investment Properties.
- Adopted Resolution 09-78 approving a modification on the current agreement for the selection of office space from Pinnacle Investment Properties.
- Approved, on first reading, an Ordinance amending the adopted budget for fiscal year 2008-2009.
- Ordinance requiring a reserve fund balance of eighty percent of the Town's annual general fund budget was withdrawn.
- Approved, on first reading, an Ordinance establishing the candidate qualifying period for the 2010 Municipal general election.
- Approved, on first reading, an Ordinance creating section 33-39.4 entitled "Temporary Outdoor Sales" and permitting certain temporary outdoor sales.
- Approved, on second reading, Ordinance 09-15, adopting roads, police, fire/rescue, public buildings and parks impact fees.
- Approved, on second reading, Ordinance 09-16, providing for the disposition of surplus materials valued less than \$5,000.00.

Tips For A Safe Halloween

2. Accompany younger children to the door of every home they approach and make sure parents and guardians are familiar with every home and all people from which the children receive treats.
3. Teach children to **NEVER** enter a home without prior permission from their parents or guardians.
4. Teach children to **NEVER** approach a vehicle, occupied or not, unless they are accompanied by a parent or guardian.
5. Make sure all children wear reflective clothing and carry a glow stick when out at dusk and at night.
6. Teach children to **NEVER** approach a home that is not well lit both inside and outside.
7. Consider organizing or attending parties at home, in schools, or in community centers as a good alternative to "Trick or Treating."
