E-Brief News

Cutler Bay is a Silver Certified Green City

Recently, the Town was awarded a Silver designation from the Florida Green Building Coalition for its efforts of becoming a green city. Achieving this designation requires local governments to meet a comprehensive list of criteria focused on improving environmental performance and Cutler Bay accomplished this in unique ways. Cutler Bay has initiated the Green Moratorium, which makes the city the first in the southeast to establish building restrictions on commercial development. The moratorium requires new developments to participate in one of the multiple sustainability certification programs, including those of the FGBC or the USGBC.



Transportation Improvements – ARRA Resurfacing Improvements

Many of the Town's Primary roadways have not been repaved in over 20 years. As part of the resurfacing improvements, 9.3 miles of the Town's arterial roadways will be resurfaced with asphalt. Such roads to be improved are Old Cutler Rd, Caribbean Blvd., Marlin Rd., SW 87th Ave., Quail Roost Dr., and Franjo Rd. In addition, damaged sidewalks along these routes will be repaired and ADA ramps added as needed. These roadway resurfacings and sidewalk improvements will lead to improved ride-ability, safety and mobility for the users of the Town's roadway and sidewalk network. - Adopted Resolution 09-87 approving Corzo Castella Carballo Thompson Salman, PA to provide design and engineering services to the Town.
- Adopted Resolution 09-88 approving an agreement for consulting services with the Wren Group.
- Approved, on second reading, an Ordinance 09-20 amending Section 2 of Ordinance 06-06 of the Town Code relating to accessory uses and structures.

Brief Legislation from the January 20, 2010 Town Council Meeting:

- Adopted Resolution 10-01 authorizing the town manager to execute an agreement with Corzo Castella Carballo Thompson Salman, PA to provide design and engineering services for the Old Cutler Road improvements.
- Adopted Resolution 10-02 urging the Secretary of the Army to grant a re-trial for Lt. Michael Behenna.
- Adopted Resolution 10-03 authorizing the issuance of an RFQ for design-build services for Lakes by the Bay Park.
