In partnership with the James L. Knight Foundation and KaBOOM!, Gulfstream Elementary will be acquiring a new playground built specifically for their students which include several children with Autism, Deaf/Hard of Hearing, as well as physically and mentally disabled children.

Gulfstream Elementary applied for a grant to help outfit their playgrounds to support their special education program and enrich their area with fully accessible and sensory rich activities. This grant was in the amount of \$75,000. Roadway and Resurfacing Improvements in Saga Bay – Phase II

The intersection of SW 85th Avenue and SW 203rd Street within Saga Bay Community will undergo stormwater improvements during the upcoming months. The improvements are expected to alleviate the existing drainage deficiencies in the area and improve the water quality of the stormwater run-off. Construction is anticipated to begin in May 2010 and substantially completed by September 2010. Traffic patterns in the area may be altered as the project progresses.



Sign Up for the Cutler Bay Summer Camp



The last day of school is just around the corner and it's time to think about what your children will do this summer. The Town of Cutler Bay offers an excellent summer for children of all ages with the safeguard that they are in good hands with experienced staff and with plenty of fun things to do. Registration will begin May 17th. Summer camp begins June 14th and runs until August 20th. The program is available to children between the ages of 6-13 years old. They will be divided into groups of 7 and under, 9 and under, 11 and under and 13 and under. Most activities, boys and girls are in separate groups.

The registration fee is \$10.00 per child and the weekly fee is \$50.00 per child and \$45.00 per week for any siblings. The program starts everyday at 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Please pack lunch and snacks for your child. There is a field trip once a week, permission slips will be sent home each week with information regarding the field trip location, time and cost. Children will have a chance to enjoy Cutler Ridge Park swimming pool each week for two hours.
