- Adopted Resolution 10-67 approving the Interlocal Agreement creating the South Dade Corridor Property Assessment Clean Energy (PACE) District;
- Adopted Resolution 10-68, authorizing issuance for a Request for Proposal (RFP) 10-05, for a third party PACE Administrator ;
- Adopted Resolution 10-69, Budget Amendment (amending Resolution 09-68, Budget Fiscal Year 09/10 – Revising the Operating and Capital Budget);
