Stormwater Asset Inventory Public Notice

The Town of Cutler Bay Public Works Department has recently contracted with an engineering firm, Calvin, Giordano & Associates (CGA) Inc., to perform an asset inventory of the town's stormwater system. The results will provide the town with a complete Geographical Information Systems (GIS) inventory of all existing stormwater drains and associated outfalls. Residents may encounter CGA staff members throughout the neighborhoods utilizing Global Positioning System (GPS) logging equipment needed to complete the stormwater inventory.

There may be circumstances in which CGA's surveying crews may require access to backyards of some properties throughout the town; this is due to the fact that some properties have dedicated drainage easements. CGA staff members will possess all the necessary identifications and their vehicles will be clearly marked with the town's logo. The project is expected to be completed by July 2011.

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Brief Legislation from the January 19th Council Meeting

- Adopted, Resolution 11-01 approving an interlocal agreement for transfer of bus shelters and bus benches from Miami-Dade County
- Adopted, Resolution 11-02 authorizing the Town Manager to purchase six replacement police motor vehicles and related equipment
- Adopted, Resolution 11-03 issuing an RFP for a web based information portal (allowing public access to the town's financial data)
- Adopted, Resolution 11-04 issuing an RFQ for general contractor(s) services (to renovate the first and second floors)
- Adopted, Resolution 11-05 issuing an RFQ for improvements in heating, ventilator, and air conditioning systems within the first and second floor
- Adopted, Resolution 11-06 issuing an RFQ for janitorial maintenance services
- Adopted, Resolution 11-07 issuing an RFQ for elevator maintenance services
- Adopted, Resolution 11-08 reappointing committee members to the parks and recreation advisory committee
- Adopted, Resolution 11-09 approving a change order for town hall improvements with KVC Constructors Inc.
- Approved on first reading, proposed ordinance amending code enforcement procedures

Brief Legislation from the February 16th Council Meeting

- Adopted, a resolution reappointing members to the Charter High School Advisory Committee
- Adopted, a resolution to reappoint an at-large committee member to the Charter High School Advisory Committee
- Adopted, a resolution to appoint two committee members to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee
- Adopted, a resolution to designate one member of the town council to act as the town's representative for the Economic Development Council and one member of the town council as the town's liaison to Chamber South.
- Adopted, a resolution urging the Florida Legislature to modify the Florida Statutes allowing for effective public notice by advertising by means other than newspapers
- Adopted, a resolution approving an interlocal agreement with Miami-Dade County for the Building Better Committees General Obligation Bond Program to include funding for Lakes-by-the-Bay Park
- Held a quasi-judicial hearing process to consider the amendment of the development order for Lakes- by- the-Bay South Commons Development
- Postponed an ordinance requiring the certificate of use for residential properties that are resold within the town, and
- Approved as amended on first reading proposed ordinance permitting entertainment center uses within the urban center district.
