November 2011 State of the Town Address highlighted the town's previous year's accomplishments; Grand Opening and Official Ribbon-Cutting Ceremonies were held at Health South Rehabilitation Hospital of Miami, Old Cutler Road Improvements Project, and Lakes by the Bay Park's Fifth Annual Home Town Harvest 10-mile Bike Ride together with the World Record title for the longest ribbon-cutting Grand Opening Ceremony.

Recent Town Actions

Approved the construction and installation of bus shelters; commenced with the construction engineering and inspection services for the Old Cutler Roadway Improvement project; accepted the 2012 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Award for \$6,262 for a fingerprinting device; revised the FY 2010/11 operating and capital budget approved agreements for the roadway and drainage improvements and construction engineering and inspection services for the SW 97 Avenue project; re-emphasized the town's commitment to maintain civility in the conduct of the public's business; called for a US Constitutional Amendment redefining the word "person"; purchased a utility vehicle; appointed a Charter Revision Commission, and approved revoking Resolution Z-27-97 relating to a property located at 22025 SW 87 Avenue.
