ORDINANCE NO. 22-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY, AMENDING FLORIDA. THE **TOWN'S** COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLAN) TO ADD A PROPERTY **RIGHTS ELEMENT AS REQUIRED BY SECTION** 163.3177(6), FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING **PROVIDING TRANSMITTAL;** FOR FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY: AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 163.3177(6), Florida Statutes, was recently amended to require each local government to include a Property Rights Element in its Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 163.3177(6)(i)(2), Florida Statutes, provides that local governments "must adopt a property rights element in its comprehensive plan by the earlier of the date of its adoption of its next proposed plan amendment that is initiated after July 1, 2021, or the date of the next scheduled evaluation and appraisal of its comprehensive plan pursuant to s. 163.3191;" and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cutler Bay (the "Town") Council desires to comply with state law and adopt a new Property Rights Element in the form prescribed by the new law; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council further desires to amend its Comprehensive Plan (Growth Management Plan) to include a Property Rights Element consistent with and pursuant to the new Law; and

WHEREAS, public notice was provided as required by applicable law; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council, sitting in its capacity as the Local Planning Agency, has reviewed this Ordinance and recommends approval; and

WHEREAS, after two duly noticed public hearings, the Town Council desires to adopt this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that this Ordinance is in the best interest and welfare of the residents of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CUTLER BAY AS FOLLOWS: $^{\rm 1}$

Section 1. Findings. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Town Comprehensive Plan (Growth Management Plan)</u> <u>Amendment</u>. The Town's Comprehensive Plan (Growth Management Plan) is hereby amended as provided in Exhibit "A," which is attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Transmittal</u>. The Town Manager or designee is authorized to transmit this Ordinance to the appropriate local, regional and state agencies.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability</u>. If any section, clause, sentence, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Conflict.</u> All sections or parts of sections of the Code of Ordinances, all ordinances or parts of ordinances, and all resolutions, or parts of resolutions, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and adoption. However, pursuant to Florida Law, the Comprehensive Plan amendment(s) adopted by this Ordinance shall not become effective until 31 days after the state land planning agency notifies the Town that the plan amendment(s) package is complete. If timely challenged, the amendment(s) do not become effective until the state land planning agency or the Administration Commission enters a final order determining the adopted amendment(s) to be in compliance.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT

PROPERTY RIGHTS ELEMENT

<u>Goal 1</u>

The Town will consider rights of property owners in all local decision-making.

Objective PRE-1 The Town will apply rules, ordinances, and regulations with sensitivity for private property rights.

Policy PRE-1A The Town shall consider in its decision-making the right of a property owner to physically possess and control his or her interests in the property, including easements, leases, or mineral rights.

Policy PRE-1B The Town shall consider in its decision-making the right of a property owner to use, maintain, develop, and improve his or her property for personal use or for the use of any other person, subject to state law and local ordinances.

Policy PRE-1C The Town shall consider in its decision-making the right of the property owner to privacy and to exclude others from the property to protect the owner's possessions and property.

Policy PRE-1D The Town shall consider in its decision-making the right of a property owner to dispose of his or her property through sale or gift.

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
