

The daily operations and administration are overseen by the Town Commander, who holds the rank of Police Major, along with the Operations Commander, who holds the rank of Police Lieutenant.





- Notify the police of any suspicious activity











PREVENTION TOP TIPS

Secure all doors and windows

Light up your home, use timer switches when out

Store keys safely and away from windows & letterboxes

Record details of valuables and don't keep large cash amounts at home

Use your alarm, even when at home





Community On Patrol (COP) App for Your Phone




The COP App allows citizens to report tips to law enforcement.

It is integrated with Miami-Dade County's Geographic Information Systems and the Miami-Dade Real-Time Crime Center.

The app will provide citizens the ability to:

- Anonymously report tips to the MDPD Command Center
- Ability to upload videos, photos and notes
- Alert 911 in emergencies
- Will identify and provide residential locations of sex offenders
- File police reports of minor incidents









